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Our Commitment to Accessibility

Augmentia is dedicated to ensuring that our websites and applications, including www.augmentia.ai and the Augmentia product suite - are accessible to all individuals, including those with disabilities. We are committed to providing an inclusive online experience for everyone which is perceivable, operable, understandable and robust. We strive to make our websites as accessible as possible and to comply with recognised accessibility standards.

WCAG 2.2 AA Compliance status

The Augmentia product and website are compliant with the Web Content Accessibility Guidelines version WCAG 2.2 level AA standard.

Accessibility is addressed systematically across the full lifecycle:

- **Design phase:** Accessibility is validated within Figma using dedicated plugins for colour contrast, labelling, and layout checks. Manual reviews are also conducted to ensure scalability, readability, and adherence to accessibility best practices before development begins.
- **Development phase:** We implement semantic HTML, structured heading hierarchies, keyboard navigability, appropriate ARIA usage, alternative text for media, and predictable focus management.
- **Testing phase:** We combine automated testing, including Google Lighthouse and/or WAVE, with structured manual validation.
- **Maintenance:** Accessibility checks are repeated during maintenance cycles to prevent regressions as the product evolves.

What we comply with

We have taken several steps to enhance the accessibility of our website and product to ensure that they meet or exceed the standards set forth by the Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) including WCAG 2.2 level AA. Here are some of the measures we have implemented:

- **Colour Contrast:** We maintain sufficient colour contrast for text and interactive elements to be readable.
- **Readable Text:** We use readable fonts and text sizes, and we allow users to adjust text size without loss of content or functionality.
- **Navigation and Consistency:** We ensure a consistent and logical navigation structure throughout our websites.
- **Form Accessibility:** We make all forms, including error messages, labels, and input fields, accessible.
- **Time-Based Media:** We ensure that time-based media (e.g., animations, slideshows) can be paused and controlled by users.
- **Page Titles and Link Text:** We use descriptive page titles and meaningful link text.
- **Consistent Language:** We maintain consistent language and avoid jargon or acronyms that may be unfamiliar.
- **Forms and Errors:** We provide clear instructions for form completion and error messages.
- **Content Reordering:** We ensure that content is presented in a meaningful sequence when styles or scripts are disabled.
- **Responsive Design:** We ensure that our websites are usable on various devices and screen sizes.

What we are working on

We recognise that there are areas where our websites can be improved to further enhance accessibility:

- **Keyboard Accessibility:** We are actively working to ensure all website functions and content can be navigated and operated using a keyboard alone.
- **Multimedia Accessibility:** We are actively working on providing captions and transcripts for audio and video content - all of our multimedia content has written content alternatives in the form of instructions or guidance.
